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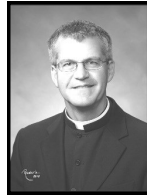
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## Knight Notes *from the President*

Over the next several years, our student enrollment will continue to grow. As a school community, we need to prepare for this forecasted growth. Recent conservative enrollment projections state that we will have an increase

of 32% in student enrollment by the year 2020. With that in mind, it is imperative that we have a quality plan for the next five years. In order to create a strategic plan for the future, we cannot rely solely on our own knowledge, information, and reflection. This is why we at Archbishop Bergan decided to personally invite a cross

section of individuals to a summit meeting that gathered all of the entities that allow Archbishop Bergan Catholic School to function. We are labeling this movement Archbishop Bergan 2020.

On Sunday April 13, 2014 in St. Patrick's Church's Delaney Hall we held a meeting to

complete an analysis of our entire school system. Individuals were invited to participate in this unique gathering because of the roles that they played in our school community. Members from the following representative groups were present at the meeting included: School Board representatives, Booster Club executive board, Parent Knight officers, Advancement Committee members, Parish Council representatives, Parish Finance committee, Alumni Board members, school staff members, and student leaders.

The Concord Mediation Center of Omaha assisted us in moderating this

event. We completed a S.W.O.T. or strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats analysis of specific areas that relate to the mission of the school. We have recently received the information that the Concord Center gathered from this meeting and will be using it to develop a five year strategic plan.

The following areas were discussed in reference to the school during the summit; Catholic Identity, Visionary Leadership, Academic & Teacher Excellence, Enrollment Management, Viable Infrastructure (Facilities & Technology) and Funding the Mission (Revenue Management).

Ultimately we at Archbishop Bergan Catholic School want to create a strategic plan that will have the most meaning and impact. Meetings like this, as well as future surveys and communications, will allow us to reach as many people as possible to contribute to the strategic planning process. Together we will make our Archbishop Bergan Catholic School the best school it can be. It truly is a great time to be a Bergan Knight!

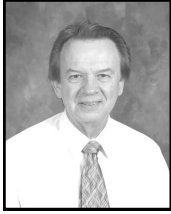

# Thank you, Neil Feser for 36 years of dedicated service



Thirty-six years ago Gary Schmidt offered me employment at Archbishop Bergan Catholic High School. Since then I have had the great fortune to work with hundreds of families, over a thousand students, many dozens of priests and faculty, nine principals and dozens of School Boards and staffs. Throughout it all I have had a myriad of blessings, interactions and seen growth through people working together to develop a strong school system. I have benefited from thousands of opportunities to develop as a person and a professional.

There have been unfortunate accidents, but in a large part because of the work of those

around me one of the things I am proudest of is never losing a student by his/her own hand. I am also proud of assisting in the development of a culture of continuing education after high school. In most years Bergan sends 100% of our graduates on to future schooling with only four or five students a decade choosing another path. In the last 12+ years the students have accepted on average over \$14,000 in college scholarships per every graduate. The offered figure is much higher. They are a credit to the work ethic developed in the home and fostered by the faculty. I helped with the paperwork.

I have grown in my faith and become a stronger believer in Catholic education. Through good times and bad I have had the benefit of seeing the school open many lives

and souls to God's love.

I have enjoyed developing and presenting short visual pieces on suicide prevention, anti-bullying, leadership and relationship building, etc. I have enjoyed presenting them in classrooms and to the student body. My next step is to get them out to the world.

I am a better man for knowing and working with the people of St. Patrick's Parish and Archbishop Bergan, its parents, staff, students and alumni. I leave with kind thoughts.

As the spring moves into the warmer temperatures of summer, another school year comes to a close. We are slotted to begin a new school year in August with 40 new kindergarteners and an additional 22 students joining the Bergan family across the various first through 12<sup>th</sup> grades. We are excited to be growing and would love to host more tours and buddy days for prospective students. You may be aware that the cost to educate a student at Archbishop Bergan Catholic School is slightly higher than the amount paid in tuition for each student. Those differences are covered by the generosity of St. Patrick's Parish, endowments made to the school, fundraisers such as the Knight Event and finally by the Bergan Annual Appeal.

We are nearing the end of the 2013-2014 campaign period for the annual appeal and we have reached 77% of our goal of \$60,000 as of this writing. Proceeds for this campaign will fund operating improvements for technology infrastructure and instructional technology. Donors to the
