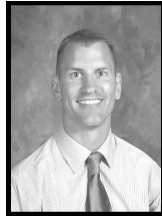

Dear Alumni,

It is with very mixed emotions that I write this as I will retire after 43 years of being employed by the school/Parish.

I began my employment in the fall of 1970 as principal of Archbishop Bergan Catholic High School. In 1973 I assumed the role of superintendent of the elementary and secondary schools and acting principal of the high school building. After retiring from the administration of the school in 2000 I established the Parish/school Development Office (now termed Advancement Office) where my primary responsibilities have been working with the

alumni and managing the endowments and other fund related activities. There are currently 45 named endowments in number with a value of over \$4 million.

I have greatly enjoyed my forty three years of involvement with the parish and school, especially my continued contact with the alumni – so many memories. I wish I would have kept a diary! My favorite event however, (except possibly watching Bergan in a state championship game), is the annual alumni reunion – seeing and visiting with all the past students. The contact with alumni is what I will miss mostly. The neatest thing about being in the same environment for 43 years has been the continued contact with

former students. Carol and I will plan to continue attending the reunion.

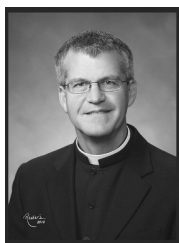
I don't have any definite plans and Carol and I intend to remain in Fremont and active with the school and Parish by attending school activities and volunteering in the Parish and of course attending Mass.

Many of our staff members have been working hard over the summer in various capacities from curriculum planning to organizing their classrooms. The custodians, kitchen staff, para educators and clerical staff have done a fantastic job of getting things cleaned, repaired, painted, waxed, organized and ready to go. Both buildings look great and were well prepared to facilitate positive learning the day that school started.

I have had many great discussions with students, parents, staff members, parishioners, community members and

- ✦ Goal #1 Archbishop Bergan Catholic School will increase overall mass participation measured through pre and post surveys of staff and students as well as worshiper observation by the end of the school year.
- ✦ Goal #2 Archbishop Bergan Catholic School will develop a welcome system

for new families to be created by January 2014 and implemented for use in the 2014-2015 school year.

- ✦ Goal #3 Archbishop Bergan Catholic School will not lose a single student this school year due to negative relationships or interactions peer to peer.
- ✦ Goal #4 Archbishop Bergan Catholic School will increase total enrollment by fifteen or more students by October 1, 2014.

I am looking forward to serving the Archbishop Bergan Family as the Principal. Please know that I have an open office policy. If there is anything I can do to be of assistance, do not hesitate to contact me. I will be keeping a schedule of being present at the Middle School/ High School Building in the mornings and the Elementary School in the afternoons. down the ramp, way into the auditorium, a

flood of memories rushed back. I
remember playing grade school basketball

restroom/locker room was still there
(where Coach Spethman had caught a few
of us sampling our first cigarettes), but I
did not look to see if the facility was still
intact.

Our group turned out to be one of the
largest of the evening, a very pleasant
surprise to me. It was really a special night
reacquainting myself with so many people
that I had spent most of my childhood
with, both in school and out.

During the evening, four people I had
never known, two worked the cash bar,
one was working the food line and one just
found me at my table, and they all asked
me if I was related to Mrs. Dorothy
Roddy, a lay teacher who began her career
teaching 6th grade at St. Pat's in 1962. As I
answered yes, they broke into huge smiles
and told me how much my mother had
meant to them. They relayed to me how

she had spent time after classes, talking to
them and advising them on what they could
do in the future. Two of these people
followed my mom's advice as to what
direction their careers should take, and to
this day, they both said they were still
working in their chosen occupations and
were still very happy. And I heard more
than once (even later from one of my own
classmates) is that the best thing about my
mother teaching there is that she was a
most "welcome break" from the priests
and nuns. Yes, that brought a smile to my
face too.

As I was driving back to Atlanta a couple
of days later, I knew that the time I had
spent making that trip to Fremont for this
particular reunion was one of the best
decisions that I have made in a long, long
time. It was a very heartwarming evening
for me, all around, and I look forward to
our 50th reunion in just five short years.

Gary Schmidt Contributor 1970–present

When it comes to long-time support and devotion to the activities of Archbishop Bergan Catholic School, the name, Gary Schmidt, tops the list.

Gary and his wife of 52 years, Carol, had five children, four of whom graduated from Bergan (Greg-1980, Michelle-1981, Deb-1982, Theresa-1984). Their oldest son, Rick, was diagnosed with leukemia and tragically passed away in 1976 at the age of 15. In his honor, an annual award is given to a Bergan freshman who displays leadership, character, involvement, and faith commitment.

Gary has served faithfully; first as principal at Archbishop Bergan and then as staff in advancement for Archbishop Bergan and St. Patrick's Parish for a total of 43 years. His service and dedication include volunteering in, but are not limited to, the Knights of Columbus, Eucharistic Ministry, Optimist Club, Chamber of Commerce, UNL Alumni Association, and Big Brothers/Big Sisters. Thank you, Gary, for your commitment to Archbishop Bergan/St. Patrick's Parish.



1959 & 1960 Football Teams



Teams in St. Patrick's/Archbishop Bergan history are hard pressed to match the success of the 1959 and 1960 football squads. They are the only teams in school history to produce back-to-back state championships, rolling to a combined record of 17-0-2. What makes the accomplishments of these teams even more noteworthy was the rapid turnaround from a winless season just three years prior to the undefeated team of 1959. Much of the credit for this remarkable development goes not only to the players and their commitment to succeed, but also to their head coach, Lou Wewel. Instilling a spirit of confidence and selflessness, Coach Wewel was the driving force that led these teams to victory and into the annals of St. Patrick's/Archbishop Bergan history.



Athlete:

Scott Poehling 1972-1976 poshumously

Debbie Poehling ('78) accepted the award for her brother Scott. Scott was the most gifted and decorated track athlete to ever wear a Bergan Knight uniform. Scott was an outstanding football and basketball player as well and was inducted into the Nebraska High School Sports Hall of Fame in 1996.

As a teammate, brother, and father, Scott consistently put others before himself. As one newspaper article put it, he was "too good to be true." Indeed he was true, and that was what made him great.

Volunteers let Their Actions be Their Voices

Hundreds of teen volunteers are letting their paint brushes, hammers and sweat be their voices as they live their faith this week in Fremont.

About 275 student volunteers are completing service projects as part of the Catholic Heart Workcamp.

The Rev. Jim Keiter, associate pastor of St. Patrick's Catholic Church, said Catholic Heart Workcamp is an organization based out of Orlando, Fla., that was started in the 1990s by a husband and wife youth ministry team in search of service trip opportunities. Finding no service trips that did not involve international travel, Keiter said the team started Catholic Heart and completed service projects in Orlando.

The camp has grown to include 50 cities and more than 15,000 youth volunteers, said Keiter. Keiter said each year the camp is blessed with great students and adults who literally come from all over the country to do the projects in Fremont.

The volunteers complete some challenging projects from pouring concrete to residing a home to

providing child care, "the sky is truly the limit to what they're doing," he said.

"But the most important day is next Monday when they go back home," Keiter added. "Because this week is about all the projects that we are doing and the work that is being completed, but more importantly it's about that transformation of them as young adults and being men and women of service no matter where they are, not just on a special retreat like this, but in their own communities, parishes and schools – their own families."

Scott Heacock, of Freedom, Wis., is working at the Habitat for Humanity Home Store by helping to reorganize the couch area, as well as move heavy items and clean the store.

Heacock has volunteered at the camp five previous years and said the work accomplished shatters any stereotype people might have of teenagers.

"People think teenagers are lazy, or they don't help people and they're self-centered," Heacock said. "Here you find a bunch of people who are not

self-centered. They're paying to go out and work to help other people."

The typical camp participant pays about \$500 to \$600 after fundraising to participate in the week-long camp.

Richard Knar of Mundelein, Ill., is helping a Fremont widow by doing yard work, cutting down dead trees and painting her house.

Knar said volunteering at the camp not only gives him a sense of belonging to a community and the ability to witness the impact volunteering can have on someone in need, but it also provides an overwhelming sense of accomplishment.

"When you come here, many things are taken away in order for you to gain something," Knar said. "Whether it be friendships, a new sense of accountability, or extending kindness to others anywhere you are."

Cindy Horeis, executive director of Rebuilding Together, said she has 12 teams of volunteers helping her organization paint, repair decks, clean gutters, install railings and build a fence at local residences.

Horeis said last year she had three teams, but saw the impact the volunteers had on the community and knew she had to do more. She said the work each volunteer is able to contribute would cost about \$25 an hour. The total value of work her teams alone will complete over the week comes out to more than \$43,000. Rebuilding Together was able to secure a \$5,000 grant from the Fremont Area Community Foundation for the Refresh, Repaint, Rebuild Together Take Two initiative. Horeis said partnering the volunteers with the foundation money allows Rebuilding Together to maximize the positive impact it can have on the community.

The volunteers working with Horeis include

Brian Arate and Alexandria Chiselk from Mundelein, Ill.; Jake Vosters and Jason VanBeek from Freedom, Wis.; and Joey Mullins and Rick Eysers from Mequon, Wis.

All the volunteers in her group, many of them new to the Catholic Heart Workcamp, said they decided to participate in the camp to not only help those in need, but to grow in their faith and as a person.

Mullins for example is helping a quadriplegic by repainting her house and repairing a wheelchair ramp, windows and doing yard work. "I feel so humbled to have the opportunity to help others out," he said.

Eysers is working with a group to build a fence for a single mother so that her son and pets can safely run around in the backyard. He said he's participated in the camp before, and now has volunteered three years as an adult leader.

"Our faith calls us to give back and to share

God's love of the world rather than just keeping it inside," he said. "People who really need it, their lives are notably improved."

Both Heacock and Knar said the camp has heavily influenced who they are, and who they intend to become in the future.

"It has influenced my career choice," Heacock said. "I want to do something that will help the community. Because of work camp I want my focus in life to be to help other people.

"St. Paul said 'preach the Gospel at all times, and when necessary use words,'" he added. "I think we're doing that here, we're preaching but not necessarily going out there and thumping the Bible."

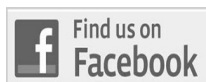
